



Registered Mental Health Nurse / Midwife

Job Description

- § Provide physical and technical care and support for patients
- § Make sure patients receive treatment prescribed by doctors and other health professionals
- § Provide emotional and psychological support and information to patients and their families
- § Supervise, or carry out, nursing care of patients
- § Observe, monitor, assess, report and document patients' conditions and responses to treatment
- § Give medication in accordance with sound working knowledge of legislation and pharmacology
- § Monitor and adjust medical equipment used in patient care and treatment, some highly technical and complex
- § Prepare patients for operations or provide post-operative care such as wound care, nutritional management, physiotherapy and rehabilitation
- § Assist in the rehabilitation of patients
- § Assist with patients' discharge planning
- § Provide first aid, assist in routine medical examinations, give advice on health matters and maintain sickness and accident records (where employed by large industrial or commercial organizations)
- § Answer questions and provide information to patients and families about treatment and care
- § Contribute to the clinical training of nursing students
- § Supervise enrolled nurses and other hospital staff.

Eligibility

- Bachelor Degree in Nursing AND
- Three years experience. AND
- Registration required. AND
- Proficiency in English language literacy and numeracy with an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall 7 and at least 6.5 in all four components.



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
